New Jersey would lose \$24.2 billion in economic activity and about 103,898 jobs if all unauthorized immigrants were removed. Latino-owned businesses had sales and receipts of **\$10.2 billion** and employed **48,059** people

Asian-owned businesses had sales and receipts of **\$29.9 billion** and employed **115,024** people

The purchasing power of Latinos is **\$43.7 billion**. Asian buying power totaled **\$44 billion**.
