

NEW AMERICANS IN RHODE ISLAND

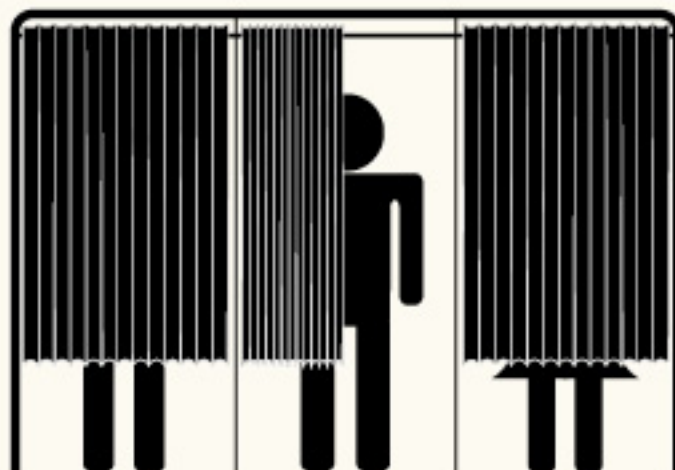


12.8% of Rhode Islanders are foreign born.

15.4% of Rhode Islanders are Latino or Asian.

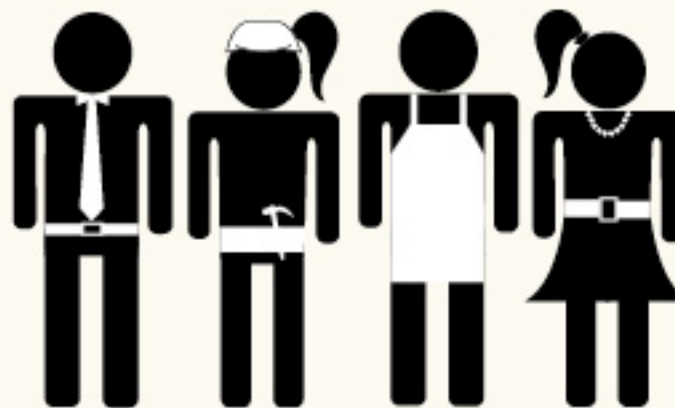
47.6% of immigrants in the state are eligible to vote.

13% of registered voters are New Americans.



Rhode Island has 4,318 foreign students who contribute **\$151.3 million** to the state economy.

21.5% of foreign-born adults have a bachelor's degree or higher.

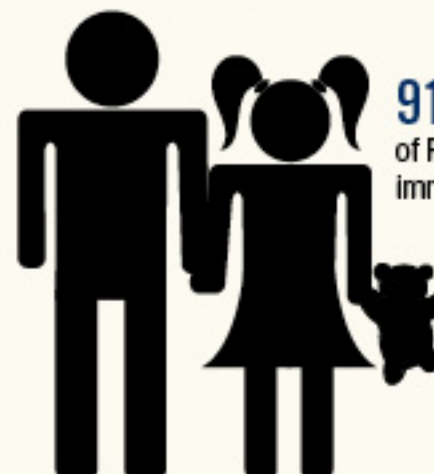


Asian-owned businesses in Rhode Island have sales and receipts of **\$583.9 million**.

Latino-owned businesses in Rhode Island have sales and receipts of **\$460.6 million**.

Immigrants are **14.9%** of the state's workforce. **3.7%** of the workforce is unauthorized.

The purchasing power of Rhode Island's Latino population and Asian population, respectively, is **\$2.4 billion** and **\$877.8 million**.



91.1% of Rhode Island's children with immigrant parents are U.S. citizens.

85.9% of children with immigrant parents are English proficient.

DID YOU KNOW? Rhode Island would lose **\$698 million** in economic activity if unauthorized immigrants were removed.
