
ORDER

On January 4, 2007, the Court entered a Consent Order granting Plaintiffs' motion for temporary restraining order and for preliminary injunction [3]. The Order also stayed this case until a final judgment was entered and appeal avenues were exhausted in the underlying cases pending in both Pennsylvania and Missouri.¹ The Court hereby DIRECTS
