**STIPULATION OF PARTIAL  
SETTLEMENT AND REVISED  
SCHEDULING ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the above entitled action by and through their undersigned counsel as follows:

1. Plaintiffs agree to the dismissal, with prejudice, of requests numbered 6 and 7 from their FOIA requests dated December 13, 2007, the subject of this civil action.
2. Defendant will produce a revised Vaughn index for Immigration and Customs Enforcement on October 31, 2008.
3. Defendant will produce those forms I-213, Record of Deportable/Inadmissible Alien which they can reasonably retrieve from their computer system called ENFORCE, redacted pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, on a rolling basis as follows:
  - a. February 22, 2006 through February 28, 2006


- b. May 9, 2006 through May 16, 2006
- c. July 27, 2006 through August 1, 2006
- d. August 21, 2006 through August 23, 2006
- e. October 16, 2006 through October 18, 2006
- f. October 28, 2006
- g. November 13, 2006 through November 17, 2006
- h. January 29, 2007 through February 1, 2007
- i. March 19, 2007 through March 30, 2007
- j. April 17, 2007 through April 26, 2007
- l. June 5, 2007 through June 20, 2007
- m. August 16, 2007 through August 25, 2007
- n. September 21, 2007 through September 26, 2007
- o. November 27, 2007 through December 7, 2007

4. The redacted forms will be produced on a rolling basis as follows: defendant will use its best efforts to produce 125 redacted forms on Nov. 21, 2008, December 5, Dec 19, Jan 16, 2009, Feb 6, Feb 20, and every 2 weeks thereafter until production is completed.

5. The Scheduling Order previously entered in this matter is revised as follows:
- a. Defendant will file its motion for summary judgment on or before December 22, 2008;
  - b. Plaintiff will file its response to the defendant's motion for summary judgment on or before January 26, 2009;

c. Defendant will file its reply to plaintiff's response to its motion for summary judgment on or before February 16, 2009.


